These two single vineyard wines are among the best reds we've tasted from Rodney Strong (going back 35 years). The Brothers Ridge is velvety and rich...It is full bodied and complex in flavor (cassis, tobacco, plum, cocoa, spicy oak), with a very persistent finish. Both plump and elegant in style. Aged 25 month in French oak barrels, 42% new. The Rockaway bottling is more powerful and tannic; a very impressive wine in its own right. It is richly flavored, full bodied, and long on the palate, with good depth and length, tasting of cassis, blackberry, toast, tobacco, and oak. Aged 25 months in French oak barrels, 49% new. 2% CF.
