"The estate high end Chardonnay program is permeating the breadth of Rodney Strong Chardonnays, leading with less obvious oak and fruit, replaced by more texture and complexity. The light, volcanic, white ash soil of the Chalk Hill appellation is at the centre of this story. The style is fresh with bright juicy, mineral, pear, apple, Meyer lemon with creamy, mineral, nutty, wet stone undertones...It's been nearly 55 years since founder Rodney Strong planted Chardonnay in what would later become the Chalk Hill American Viticultural Area (AVA), established officially in 1983." - A.G.
