



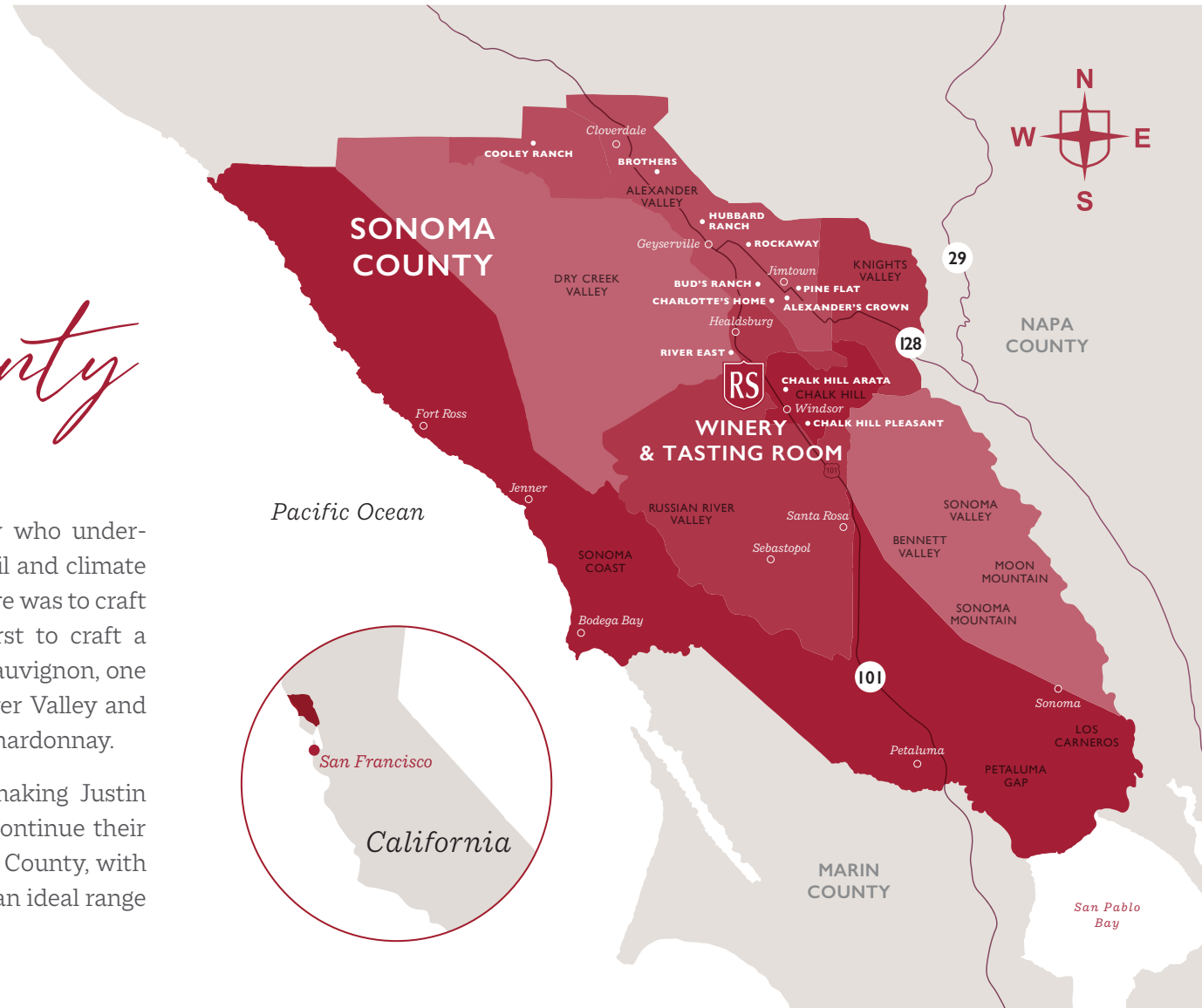

AN EARLY PIONEER

Rod Strong was an acknowledged visionary who understood the potential that Sonoma County's soil and climate held for producing world-class wines. His desire was to craft wines from a specific place. He was the first to craft a single-vineyard Alexander Valley Cabernet Sauvignon, one of the first to plant Pinot Noir in Russian River Valley and the first to produce a Chalk Hill appellation Chardonnay.

Today, the Klein Family, Director of Winemaking Justin Seidenfeld, and Winemaker Greg Morthole continue their drive for innovation and devotion to Sonoma County, with 11 exceptional Estate vineyards representing an ideal range of varietal selection and regional terroir.
