With 60 years of family ownership and 1,158 acres of estate vineyards, we exemplify Cabernet at every price point and what it means to be world class Sonoma quality.


From the cellar workers to the winemakers, from the office staff to the tasting room team, from our founder Rod Strong to our family owners, we are one big family.



ROD STRONG - FOUNDER

Our story begins over 60 years ago, when a celebrated American dancer named Rod Strong settled in Sonoma County to pursue a second lifelong creative passion: winemaking. Rod Strong was an acknowledged visionary who understood the potential that Sonoma County's soil and climate held for producing world-class wines. Rodney Strong Vineyards established Sonoma County's 13th bonded winery in 1959.







ALEXANDER VALLEY

A pioneer in the Alexander Valley, Rod Strong was the first to craft a single-vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon in the Alexander Valley in 1974. It would be a full decade before this appellation was recognized as an AVA. Alexander Valley is best known for the classic Bordeaux varieties which thrive in the unique soils and warm climate, with parts of the valley moderated by cooling ocean breezes and evening fog.

A testament to the amazing quality of the region, each of our single vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon releases comes from small Alexander Valley vineyard sites.

CHALK HILL

The first to see the potential of the Chalk Hill area as an exceptional place for Chardonnay, Rod planted his first Chardonnay vines in 1965 and in 1977, he introduced the world to the first "Chalk Hill" labeled Chardonnay.

In 1983, Chalk Hill was designated an official AVA, in an effort spearheaded by Rod Strong himself. The ocean fog and chalky-white volcanic soils combine to produce distinctive Chardonnays that offer crisp citrus and mineral tones supported by lush floral notes and a rich baked apple character.

KNIGHTS VALLEY

Knights Valley is the easternmost appellation in Sonoma County, lying just north of Calistoga at the foot of Mount Saint Helena. Protected from the direct influence of the Pacific Ocean, Knights Valley is the warmest of Sonoma County's viticultural areas. Bordeaux varietals thrive in the warm days and cool nights that Knights Valley is known for.

RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY

In 1968, Rod Strong was one of the first to plant Pinot Noir in the Russian River Valley, again recognizing the potential of this appellation. The Russian River Valley was formally recognized as an AVA in 1983.

Well-known as one of the finest cool-climate growing regions in California, the Russian River Valley has made its mark not only as a premier Chardonnay region, but as one of the few wine regions in the world capable of producing world-class Pinot Noir. The Russian River Valley is also home to our Tasting Room in Healdsburg, California.

NORTHERN SONOMA

The Northern Sonoma appellation covers most of Sonoma County with the notable exceptions of the Los Carneros and Sonoma Valley AVAs, which are located in the southern portion of the county. The second largest AVA within Sonoma County, almost every grape variety that can be grown in Sonoma County thrives in Northern Sonoma.

Our latest crowning achievement in this AVA is the planting of perhaps the last of the greatest vineyards in Sonoma County, Cooley Ranch Vineyard. This high elevation vineyard sits well above the fog line and Lake Sonoma on a pristine property ranging up to 2,040 feet in elevation.



Our RED WINES

Rod Strong recognized Sonoma County as an ideal place to grow Cabernet Sauvignon as far back as 1971, when he planted our first Cabernet vineyard on Alexander's Crown in Alexander Valley.

Today we proudly farm four different estate vineyards, like in Alexander Valley where Cabernet displays the finest expression of the terroir. Our Single Vineyard wines embody Tom Klein's vision of the very best Cabernet Sauvignons from Alexander Valley.

With a pedigree of place captured, they are 100% estate grown, single vineyard in origin and exemplify the very best winemaking practices in the world.

ALEXANDER'S CROWN

CABERNET SAUVIGNON Alexander Valley



Single Vinegard

Alexander's Crown was the first Sonoma County vineyard to be bottled as a single vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon. This wine exhibits ripe flavors of black currant, blackberries and violets. The wine is voluptuous, has a rich mouthfeel, soft tannins and a long lingering finish with notes of dried herbs and a touch of mocha.

Zingle Vineyard

The Rockaway vineyard site is planted primarily to Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot, and includes all five of the classic Bordeaux varieties. This wine showcases concentrated flavors of dark plum and red currant with notes of tobacco and leather. The earthy minerality of the wine is balanced out by notes of baking spices with a rich, complex structure and a long lingering finish.



Brothers vineyard is planted to Cabernet Sauvignon and Malbec. This deeply rich wine is complex with flavors of dark berries and cassis and is bursting with blackberry, plum and wonderful chocolate and mocha notes followed by a round and seductive mid-palate and a long lingering finish.

SYMMETRY RED WINE Sonoma County



With luxurious aromas of red fruit, plum, vanilla, and dried fruit, our signature red blend unfolds on the palate with silky layers of dark fruits, baking spices and a supple, rich mouthfeel.

Aromas of lush, red plum and dark berries with hints of cassis and milk chocolate. The dried fig and chewy tannins give this wine a strong backbone, while barrel aging softens the finish of this bold wine.



RODNEY STRONG











Rich, lush and structured, with

intense flavors of blackberry, black

currant, cocoa and crushed violet,

this Cabernet Sauvignon is velvety,

with a lingering finish of vanilla

and cocoa.

Deeply colored and bursting with aromas of crushed blackberries, wild raspberry and spicy dark plum, this wine has complex layers of spice and chocolate framed in rich, velvety tannins.



Rich with dark cherry, plum and baking spices, accompanied by black pepper notes, crushed violet and cassis. Ends with lingering spicy oak flavors and a velvety lush finish.



Lovely aromas of red fruit, floral and earth with a soft and silky texture on the palate that has a beautiful lingering finish.



Fresh aromas of bright berry fruit combined with ripe, peppery jam, this wine offers flavors of blackberry, plum and boysenberry with layers of toast and baking spices. full and lively finish.



This rich supple wine bursts Lush with notes of blackberry, with blackberry and dark fig compote and cassis. Medium bodied with soft cherries with hints of spice tannins, this wine boasts toasty followed by lush rounded oak and spice punctuated by a tannins and a lingering finish.





WHIE WINES

Rod Strong was an acknowledged visionary who understood the potential that Sonoma County's soil and climate held for producing world-class wines. His desire was to craft wines from a specific place. He was the first to craft a single-vineyard Alexander Valley Cabernet Sauvignon, one of the first to plant Pinot Noir in Russian River Valley and the first to produce a Chalk Hill appellation Chardonnay. We continue that visionary leadership today by crafting critically acclaimed Sonoma County wines vintage after vintage.

CHARDONNAY Chalk Hill



A wine with elegant fullness that is both creamy and crisp with flavors of golden pear, vanilla, Meyer lemon and a hint of minerality on the long finish.

ROSÉ OF PINOT NOIR

Russian River Valley



This beautifully colored fresh and vibrant Rosé has aromas and flavors of strawberry, melon, and tropical fruits. Brilliant and bright with fresh acidity and notes of citrus with a clean finish.

CHARLOTTE'S HOME SAUVIGNON BLANC Sonoma County

CHARDONNAY California



Named for Rod Strong's wife, Charlotte, our fresh, bright and crisp Sauvignon Blanc leads with zesty citrus notes of grapefruit, Meyer lemon and a light grassiness. This classic Sonoma County style Sauvignon Blanc ends with clean, refreshing acidity.

RODNEY STRONG



Creamy with a touch of spice and vanilla, showcasing aromas of lemon curd and apple with hints of toasty oak and baking spices. The finish is long and lingering with silky notes of fresh pear and pineapple.

Our commitment to community began in 1959, when winemaking pioneer, Rod Strong envisioned Sonoma County as a special place for crafting wines. 

- The different temperatures, climates, topography and elevation of each vineyard site lead to the right mouth feel in every wine.
- · Cabernet Sauvignon thrives on all four sites but makes different wines. We are proud to be one of the few wineries to craft wine from all four world class vineyard sites.
- We have the ability to make pure forms of Cabernet from each site that all taste unique and then also take all the sites and weave them together to create very different but complete and balanced wines.
- Site specific wines, like our Cabernets from these sites, truly allow us to showcase all of the world class quality in Sonoma County.



SUSTAINABILTY

As a family-owned winery, we are committed to doing everything we can to preserve the earth for generations to come. This means using sustainable practices now. We have gone acre by acre through our Estate properties to ensure we are taking every step we can to safeguard this region's ecosystem and continue to focus on sustainability.

Sustainability matters in Sonoma County where 99% of the vineyard acreage is certified sustainable

Quality

Sustainability begins in the vineyards with a focus on balanced vines and choosing the right vines, rootstock and clones for the vineyard. The right vines allow the focus to be on the grapes and that creates the best quality wine.

Soil Health

We sustainably build soil health by carefully selecting cover crops that aid in building organic material in the soil, increase nutrients and improve soil structure.

Water Management

We use deficit irrigation in all estate vineyards which saves water and improves fruit quality, especially in red varietals as the vines concentrate on fruit production. All our ranches are set up with drip irrigation and we can water one vine at a time.

Habitat

Long-term sustainability of the wildlife habitat in and around our vineyards is important and we look at it across elements from waterways to bird boxes to the bugs crawling through the vineyard.

BARREL STORY

Barrels are the finishing touch – they are used to add detail, polish and layers along with balance to our wines.



We buy approximately 8,000 barrels a year. Barrels add the finishing touch to an already beautiful base of the best grapes from exceptional vineyards.

- · BARREL FUTURES we visit France every year to choose our trees, not premade barrels, to ensure quality in every step & we can trace every barrel back to the trees
- OUR BARRELS are aged in dedicated seasoning yards in France & Italy for 24-60 months
- · OUR BARRELS are customized to us alone with 190 different toast profiles ensuring every single detail of oak in our wines
